## MULTI-YEAR GRANT PARTNERS (2018 – 2020)

### **Innovation Ohio Education Fund: Ohio Women's Public Policy Network**

The Ohio Women's Public Policy Network is a coalition unlike any other group in the state; pulling together over 20 key women's advocacy organizations focused on promoting policies that create economic security for women and strengthen Ohio families.

### **Planned Parenthood of Greater Ohio: Peer Education Program**

The Peer Education Program successfully recruits and trains teenage women to be peer educators; participants receive training in an evidence-based prevention curriculum to directly educate their peers and community members on preventing unintended pregnancies, reducing sexually transmitted infections, and combating harmful gender stereotypes.

### **Policy Matters Ohio: Improving Childcare Policy**

Improving Childcare Policy, specifically builds economic self-sufficiency for Ohio women by advocating for state policies that help families afford quality childcare, thus providing women a greater opportunity to advance their careers.

## ANNUAL GRANT PARTNERS

### ECONOMIC EMPOWERMENT: WOMEN'S HEALTH

#### **Bhutanese Community of Central Ohio (BCCO): W.O.K.E.**

Through a peer learning model, Women of Knowledge and Excellence (W.O.K.E.) will nurture women's leadership and build community dialogue around sex education and healthy relationships in a space that fosters peer support and increases self-efficacy among young Bhutanese women.

#### **Equitas Health: LBT Sexual Health Education Pilot**

This pilot will test a culturally appropriate sexual health education "boot camp" for lesbian, bisexual, and transgender (LBT) youth.

#### **Restoring Our Own Through Transformation (ROOTT): Going to the ROOTT**

Going to the ROOTT is a curriculum that targets teens and their caregivers, focusing on developing teen self-awareness and reducing intergenerational stigma via comprehensive, medically accurate sex education.

#### **Nationwide Children's Hospital Foundation: Contraceptive Access Collaborative**

Nationwide Children's Contraceptive Access Collaborative removes barriers to reproductive healthcare and contraception access for young women; this program provides patient and family-centered counseling and same-day contraception, including long-acting reversible contraceptives (LARC), to female patients ages 15-19.

### LEADERSHIP: ADVOCACY

#### **John Glenn College of Public Affairs: NEW Leadership & Ready to Run**

NEW Leadership and Ready to Run will provide leadership training to women who want to run for office, work on political campaigns, and serve as leaders and advocates in their communities. Both initiatives are part of Programs for Ohio Women Empowered to Represent (POWER) at the John Glenn College of Public Affairs.

#### **LEAD Ohio: Women LEADing Ohio**

LEAD Ohio strives to identify, empower, and support progressive leaders throughout Ohio. Women LEADing Ohio informs women of the importance and opportunity to run for office; empowers them with the tools and skills required to run for office and to be an impactful leader; and equips both men and women to see policy and laws through an intersectional gender lens.

#### **League of Women Voters of Ohio: Women's Voices Training the Next Generation of Women Leaders**

Women's Voices develops young women leaders in civics and public policy through dialogues, mentorship programs, and through Young Women's Day of Action at the Ohio Statehouse where students conduct direct advocacy related to policies they care about. 100% of eligible girls participating in the program will be registered to vote, equipped with the tools to be active and informed voters, and future voters will be engaged through informal voter registration and Voter Girl, a partnership with Girl Scouts.

### LEADERSHIP: ADVOCACY (cont.)

#### **Muslim Family Services of Ohio: New Voter-Smart Voter**

New Voter-Smart Voter will empower a community of new and potential voters (including immigrant and refugee women) to be well informed of their voting rights and responsibilities as well as ways to access the tools to be ballot-wise voters.

#### **Us Together Inc.: The Young Women Civic Engagement Tours**

The Young Women Civic Engagement Tours initiative strives to launch a leadership pipeline among young immigrant and non-immigrant high school girls through civic/voter education and advocacy in the following three areas: women and immigration issues; voting and voter registration; and civic education.

#### **VoteRunLead: RunAsYouAre™**

VoteRunLead aims to bring to Central Ohio the RunAsYouAre™ nonpartisan leadership development experience, which consists of in-person and online leadership trainings in order to activate a diverse group of local women to lead in their communities and create positive change. RunAsYouAre™ is designed to demystify the campaign process, encourage civic participation, and lead women through a process of radical self-inquiry to help them identify and articulate their unique value.

### LEADERSHIP: WOMEN AND GIRLS

#### **Boys and Girls Clubs of Columbus: Girls with Great Futures**

Girls with Great Futures applies a gender lens to typical career and leadership development programs to address the needs and challenges specific to our girls while educating our boys on the consequences of gender norms, especially those specific to our girls' communities and culture.

#### **Eryn PiNK Ltd. : Lunch Box Girl Talk School Program, Give That Girl the Mic, She's Gold Workshops**

Eryn PiNK programs offer a strong foundation, providing support, tools, resources and mentorship to empower girls - especially black girls - to speak up now and in the future to create a more equitable reality where they are comfortable advocating for themselves and their families.

### LEADERSHIP: WOMEN AND GIRLS (cont.)

#### **Femergy: The Enrichment Institute for Women (EIW)**

EIW, Executed in partnership with Otterbein University, is composed of an intense thirteen session curriculum that prepares women in the areas of personal development, financial fitness, organizational leadership, board governance, and wellness.

#### **Helpline of Delaware & Morrow Counties, Inc.: Thank Goodness I'm Female Training Central Ohio (TGIF)**

Thank Goodness I'm Female and Girl Action League are a multi-tiered female youth-led prevention program designed to empower 6th-12th grade girls to reach their full potential, gain leadership skills, and reduce incidences of relational aggression.

#### **Otterbein: The Otterbein Women's Leadership Network**

The Otterbein Women's Leadership Network, known as "The NET," provides a stream of educational, networking, and transformational leadership opportunities for girls, university students, and women community leaders. The NET grounds its work in a social change paradigm that debunks myths about the leadership of women and girls and dissolves negative stereotypes with a special focus on the STEAM mindset. We will mobilize over 1000 participants and 100 organizations through intergenerational opportunities.

#### **Proyecto Mariposas: Valiente | Fuerte**

Valiente | Fuerte (Brave and Strong) is an 11-week leadership development program that serves Latina girls and their mothers in their native language and with cultural competency. The core program is led by the issues that girls identify, such as self-esteem and confidence, mental and emotional health, and public speaking.

#### **Community Properties Impact Corporation: Women with Voices Toastmasters Club**

Women with Voices Toastmaster Club empowers women for successful civic engagement and career advancement by increasing leadership skills including communication and public speaking.
